

Day to day Description 3D2N Brunei (ex-Miri)



Day 01 : Miri - Brunei

In the morning you will be picked up from the hotel in Miri, for the journey overland to Bandar Seri Begawan, the capital of the Sultanate of Brunei. Please keep your passport handy, as you will be crossing the Sarawakian and Bruneian borders, both of them with immigration check. Arrive in Brunei, and continue with the local guide on an exploration of the Sultanate. You will drive up to past the Lapau, the Dewan Majlis, and the Sir Omar Ali Saifuddien Mosque, visiting the Tamu (Open Market), the Malay Technology Museum, the Brunei Museum, and the tomb of the fifth Sultan of Brunei (Sultan Bolkiah 1485-1524). Later, proceed for a scrumptious lunch at a local restaurant before continuing your day of discovery by visiting the Royal Regalia Centre and the Sultan's Palace (Istana Nurul Iman).



After that, you will take a water taxi to the Kampung Ayer (literally translates to "Water Village"). There, you will visit a house-on-stilts, where local cakes and tea will be served, and then the last visit will be to the new Jame' Asr Hassanil Bolkiah Mosque before the transfer to the hotel for check-in. Spend the evening free at leisure exploring the markets or coffeeshops nearby the hotel.

Day 02: Brunei

Your day nature escapade starts with a picked-up by our guide from your hotel in Brunei at 07.00am for your trip to Ulu Temburong. Short drive to the nearby jetty, and then continue your one hour journey to the National Park by long boat, through the scenic river. During dry season or low water, you will have the privilege of getting wet and help to push the long boat upstream against the water currents. Ulu Temburong National Park occupies approximately 50,000ha of the Batu Apoi Forest Reserve which is located in the Temburong district. The park's locality, steepness and swampy terrain have limited human impact on the area and helped preserve its rich biodiversity. Upon arrival at the park centre, register and get your park entry pass before proceeding on your nature hike and canopy walk adventure. An established 7 KM of wooden walkways forest trails through the park, which protect the ground vegetation and help to prevent erosion, are the best way to explore the local flora and fauna. A canopy walkway gives visitors the opportunity to observe the rainforest's diverse treetop ecosystem. At noon, stop by at the facilities available at the park for lunch. In the afternoon, proceed back to Bandar Town, with a transfer back to your hotel.
